Please be advised that applicants in a preference category must meet the following criteria for eligibility:

- 1. **NC BoS CoC Priorities** households ready to move on and/or with highest length of unsheltered homelessness and/or on current regional CE By Name List who need long term rental assistance.
- 2. **Homeless** as defined in section 103(a) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, which is codified in HUD's CoC program regulations at 24 CFR 578.3.
- 3. **At risk of homelessness** as defined in section 401(1) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, which is codified in HUD's CoC Program regulations at 24 CFR 578.3. Applicant is under the age 62.
- 4. Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking (includes HUD-assisted emergency transfers) as defined by HUD.
- 5. **Recently homeless** defined as families who have previously been classified by a member agency of the CoC as homeless but are not currently homeless as a result of homeless assistance, temporary rent assistance or some type of other assistance, and where the CoC determines that the loss of such assistance would result in a return to homeless or the family having a high risk of housing instability.
