This service allows the public, community groups, environmental organizations and resource agencies to quickly access current information about environmental reviews coordinated by the Clearinghouse. The *North Carolina Environmental Bulletin* includes the following information for each environmental document under active review:

| Received Date | The date the document was entered into the State Environmental Review Clearinghouse database |
| SCH Number | The State Clearinghouse Number - the unique number assigned to the document for record keeping and project tracking |
| Type | Indication that the document was submitted pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) or the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), and indication of what type of document it is (i.e., Scoping, Environmental Assessment, Finding of No Significant Impact, Environmental Impact Statement, Record of Decision, Other) |
| Review Close Date | Deadline for submitting comments on the document to the State Environmental Review Clearinghouse |
| Applicant | The entity that submitted the environmental document to the State Environmental Review Clearinghouse. Three types of applicants are common: 1) the government entity planning to undertake the proposed projects, 2) the state agency considering taking action on the proposed activity, and 3) the consultant that prepared the environmental document |
| Description | A brief description of the proposed activity |
| Region | The code for the Council of Governments region in which the proposed project would be located |
| County | The county where the proposed project would be located |
| Contact/Phone | Name and phone number of person to contact for more information about the proposed project |
