

# **NEW Statewide Term Contract**

Effective Dates: May 1, 2022 – April 30, 2027

## Locking Devices & Accessories -4617A

The Division of Purchase & Contract has established a new statewide term contract to provide locking devices and accessories.

This is a mandatory contract for state agencies, departments, institutions, universities, and community colleges - unless exempted by North Carolina General Statute. Additionally, nonmandatory entities, including schools and local governments, that are allowed by North Carolina General Statute may use this contract.

### **New Contract Highlights**

This contract covers the state's normal requirements for locking devices and accessories in the following categories:

Category B	Combination Padlocks (Non-Key), Combination
	Padlocks (Key Control)
Category C	Auxiliary Locks, Deadbolts
Category D	Electronic Locks and Component
Category E	Exit Devices
Category F	Door Lock Sets, Door Lock Sets Less Core
Category G	Lock Cores/Cylinders
Category H	Door Closers
Category I	Key Blanks, Key Machines, Pinning Kit, Door
	Protectors, Cabinet Locks, Butts & Hinges
