SEE NC Curriculum

The SEE NC online curriculum is a selfpaced, web-based training on human trafficking. It provides an introduction to human trafficking and covers best practices for serving victims and survivors of trafficking, including identification, collaborative service provision, and aftercare for survivors who have exited their trafficking situation.

The curriculum is designed with service providers in mind but is free and available to the general public.



Why should I take the training?



The SEE NC curriculum will strengthen your ability to respond to human trafficking in your own community by building a strong

foundation on what trafficking is and how to respond to it. Additionally, the curriculum offers downloadable resources, a certificate of completion, and access to additional training support for your agency.

What is SEE NC?

Seek, Empower, Engage North Carolina (SEE NC) focuses on interdisciplinary collaboration to improve identification and response to human trafficking in marginalized and underserved communities. The three primary components of SEE NC are:

- Interagency collaboration
- Accessible culturally-specific resources
- Training and technical assistance
